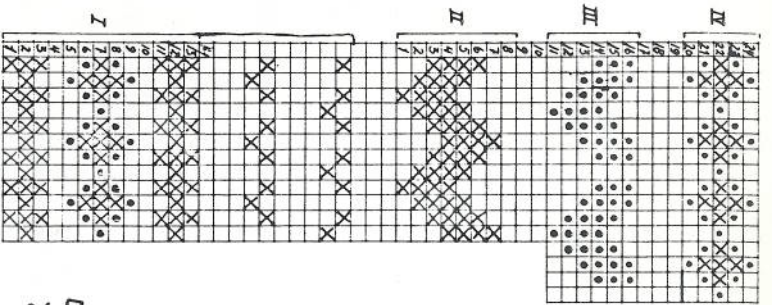
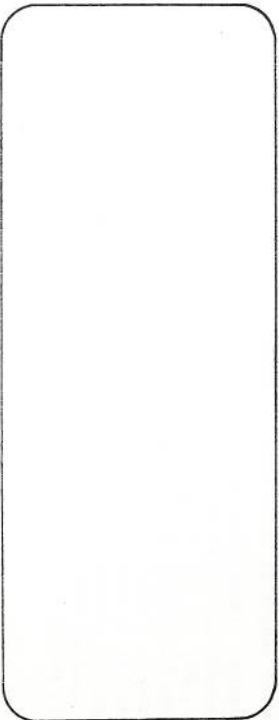

PATTERN NO. 159. JUMPER, TROUSERS AND HAT IN LOPPI LIGHT.

Sizes:	Jumper and Hat	8/18mths. 18mths/2yr. 4	6	8yrs.

ACTUAL MEASUREMENTS.

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MATERIALS Jumper and Hat

LOPPI LIGHT	3	(3)	4	(4)	5 balls
basic colour	2	(2)	2	(2)	2 balls
contrast 1.	1	(1)	2	(2)	2 balls

Trousers	2	(2)	balls
Loppi Light basic colour	1	(1)	balls

(If trousers are made without "flea pattern" 1 ball more of basic colour may be needed).

Circular needles 4 and 5 mm 40 cm length  
Set of 4 4 and 5 mm  
1 button if hat has earflaps.

TENSION 18 sts. x 20 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm over stocking stitch.  
Change to smaller or larger needles to obtain correct tension.

JUMPER

Back and front in one piece. With basic colour, using 4 mm needles cast on 80 (86) 92 (100) 110 stitches. Join, and knit rib K1, P1 for 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 ~~cm~~, placing thread to mark end of round. Change to 5 cm needles. Knit 1st round, increasing evenly to 100 (104) 108 (120) 124 sts.

Remainder of pattern I and introducing contrast colours as shown on diagram knit 13 rounds. Alternating patterns are completed, or length required.

Note sizes 6 and 8 only. When 5 flea patterns have been knitted inc. 1 st. at beg. and end of next round. This is also done at end of 6th and 7th flea patterns.

Knit 3 rounds in basic colour; casting off 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 sts. on each side for armholes in 3rd round.

Leave body and commence sleeves knit 2.

Using 4 mm set of 4 needles and basic colour cast on 26 (26) 28 (28) 28 sts.

Join work, and knit rib; knit 1, purl 1 for 10 (12) 13 (13) 14 rounds.

Next round change to 5 mm set of 4 needles and knit 1 round, increasing evenly to 36 (36) 40 (40) 40 sts. Knit pattern I for 1st 13 rounds, then flea pattern 4 (5) 6 (7) 8 times. After flea patterns knit 3 rounds in basic colour casting off 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 sts. for armhole.

Yoke

Using the 5 mm circ. needle and basic colour knit sts. from jumper front, 1 sleeve, jumper back, 2nd sleeve. 148 (152) 160 (176) 182 sts. Mark end of round.

Next round dec. to 144 (150) 156 (174) 180 sts.

Now work pattern II, then 1 round in basic colour.

Next round, dec. evenly to 112 (120) 128 (136) 144 sts.

Knit 1 round basic colour, then knit pattern III.

Knit 1 round basic colour. Next row dec. evenly to 84 (88) 92 (96) 100 sts. Knit 1 round basic colour. Knit pattern IV. Knit 3 rounds basic colour dec. to 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 sts. in 2nd round.

Change to 4 mm needles and knit rib (K1, P1) for 10 (12) 14 (16) 18 rounds\*  
If jumper is to have crew neck cast off very loosely.

Making Up.

Fold neck band in half and catch down. Join cast off edges of body to armhole in sleeve. Darn in all loose ends.

Press jumper on wrong side using damp cloth.

For roll neck jumper continue from \*  
K1, P1 in each knit stitch in first round. Then P2, K1, for 12 (14) 16 (18) 20 rnds. Cast off loosely in rib.

Make Up.

Join underarm sts. as for crew neck jumper, darn in loose threads and press.

Trousers. Knit 2 legs both alike.

Using 5 mm needles and basic colour cast on 48 (52) sts.

Knitting backwards and forward i.e. 1 row plain, 1 row purl work 6 (8) rows. Work 15 rows of pattern I\*\*

If desired to omit "flea pattern" continue in basic colour until leg measures 26 (30) cm x length desired.

If using "flea pattern" continue from \*\* and work 3 rows basic colour, then repeat "flea pattern" 6 (7) times or length required.

Place both legs on needle, place marker for beg. of round and using basic colour join work and proceed to work in rounds, inc. 2 sts. at the beg. and end of each leg 104 (112) sts. Continue in either basic colour or "flea pattern" until work measures 11 cm for both sizes from joining of legs. Next round dec. 4 sts. on each side of legs.

Repeat this dec. when body measures 17 cm for both sizes.

Size: 8/18mths. Work 6 rounds, K2, P2. Cast off loosely in rib.

Size: 18mths/2yrs. Continue until body measures 20 cm, then work 8 rounds K1, P2. Cast off loosely in rib.

Make Up.

Thread elastic through rib. Join leg seams. Turn lower edge of legs to form hem and catch lightly. Darn in loose ends. Press.

HAT

Using 4 mm circ. needle and basic colour cast on 60 (60) 64 (68) 72 sts.

Join and work K1, P1, rib for 11 (12) 13 (14) 16 rounds. Change to 5 mm needle and knit 1 round basic colour, then 13 rounds pattern I and then flea pattern.

Size: 8/18 mths. After 2 flea patts. and 3 rows basic colour.

Size: 18mths/2yrs. After 3 flea patts.

Size: 4 yrs. After 3 flea patts. and 3 rows basic colour.

Size: 6 yrs. After 4 flea patts.

Size: 8 yrs. After 4 flea patts. and 3 rows basic colour.

Thread sts. on length of wool, pull together and fasten off.

Size: 8/18 mths. 18mths/2yr. ear flaps.

With 4 mm needle and basic colour pick up 13 (15) sts. on rib edge 5 sts from start/end of row. K1, P1, rib for 14 (16) rows. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows 8 (10) sts.

Next row make buttonhole by casting off 2 sts. in centre.

Next row cast on 2 sts. over buttonhole. Knit 2 rows rib. Cast off.

Knit 2nd earflap by picking up 13 (15) sts. leaving 10 sts. between 2 earflaps at back of hat. Knit to correspond omitting buttonhole. Sew on button, darn in loose threads.

Press. If desired make pom pom and sew to top of hat.

If desired a thread of invisible nylon thread can be used with the Loppi wool to strengthen seams.

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
